

Direct Cremation

At Thames Valley Cremation Services Inc., a simple cremation means exactly that. We look after every step before, during, and after the cremation process with care, respect, and professionalism. We are a licensed Transfer Service Operator (Class 1), providing direct cremation services and coordinating everything needed for the cremation to take place. A licensed funeral director takes care of everything and guides the family through each stage of the process.

We transfer the deceased into our care, complete all necessary documentation, and coordinate with the crematorium. Your loved one is safely sheltered in our private, secure facility until the cremation takes place. The executor or next of kin signs all the required documents. We also handle all required paperwork, including death registration, burial permit, and coroner's cremation certificate. We transfer your loved one to the crematorium, return the cremated remains to the executor or next of kin, and provide Proof of Death Certificates for estate and legal purposes.

Preparation of Deceased	No Charge
The preparation of a deceased individual for cremation involves several key steps. Identification and confirmation of the deceased, jewelry and personal effects removal (if applicable), and the placement of the deceased into the cremation container.	
Transfer to the Crematorium	No Charge

If cremation is not what you want, we offer an economical direct burial service — without viewing, visitation, or services. Direct burial services are a growing choice for families who prefer simplicity and practicality.

If you are considering this option, there is no cost or obligation to speak with a licensed funeral director. We will provide you with clear information so you can take your time and make the decision that feels right for you and your family.

Our direct burial package includes the transfer of the deceased from the place of death to our licensed holding room, sheltering in our care until the required documentation is completed, placement into a casket of your choosing, and transportation by service van or SUV directly to the cemetery, where

the casket is placed at the grave. We will dress the deceased if clothing is provided; however, we do not offer the full services of a funeral home, such as embalming, washing, viewing, or visitation. Once the casket has been placed at the grave, the family takes over from there, as we are not permitted to participate in the graveside service.

Families are welcome to create their own graveside service or quiet gathering — all arranged by them. They may invite a clergy member or officiant, play meaningful music from a phone or speaker, bring flowers to place at the grave, or include readings, prayers, or personal tributes. These moments, simple and heartfelt, allow families to say goodbye in a way that feels right for them.

Pre-Planning

Trust and Guarantee

All money paid under a pre-need contract with Thames Valley Cremation Services Inc. is placed in trust with Guaranteed Funeral Deposits of Canada (GFD) and in accordance with the Funeral, Burial and Cremation Services Act, 2002 and Ontario Regulation 30/11. The money is not placed into our general operating account. It remains in trust, with all income earned, until the licensed supplies or services are provided.

Thames Valley Cremation Services Inc. handles all the paperwork and documentation for your pre-arrangement during your appointment with a licensed funeral director. Together, we complete the pre-need contract and trust forms, and the licensed funeral director submits the information directly to GFD.

You may choose to pay the full amount at once or make monthly payments directly into trust. Payments can be made by automatic bank withdrawal, Visa, or MasterCard, and are forwarded directly to GFD for deposit into trust. Once your payment is processed, GFD will issue a trust certificate(s). Funds are held in the purchaser's name for the benefit of the beneficiary, who may be the same person or a different person.

When the pre-need contract is paid in full in accordance with the payment terms set out in the contract, the prepaid contract becomes guaranteed. The total payments made, along with any interest or growth earned, will be applied to the future cost of the services and supplies. If the total payments plus interest are insufficient to cover the full future price, Thames Valley Cremation Services Inc. will absorb the difference as a loss. If the trust funds exceed the total future price, the surplus will be refunded to the estate or to the person designated by the purchaser. (Conditions apply).

It's important to understand that a pre-need contract does not authorize cremation services or burial services. At the time of death, the legally authorized representative (executor or next of kin) must sign an at-need contract confirming the services, supplies, and disbursements. Once the licensed supplies or services are provided, the trust funds are released from GFD to Thames Valley Cremation Services Inc.

- Cancel the deceased's CPP and OAS benefits — to avoid overpayments
- Provide services for CPP Death Benefit and Survivor's Pension applications
- Review the Thames Valley Cremation Services Post Checklist with the family during their appointment

We provide general guidance and helpful resources for common administrative tasks, such as cancelling a health card, driver's licence, or passport. Each family's situation is different — some may choose to manage these tasks on their own, while others may prefer additional professional services, such as Peacehold, which offers Estate Documentation and Identity Theft Protection services following a death.

Families may also wish to consult their accountant or legal representative for advice in more complex estate matters.

Payment is due in full upon signing the contract.
